

## Clean-up Program Changes

### On-Call Bulky Item Pick-Up Service Is Now Available For Unincorporated Fresno County Residents and Businesses

July 1, 2009

On May 12, 2009, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors voted to suspend the previous curbside and drop-off community clean-up program. Therefore Exclusive Service Area Program (ESAP) Waste Haulers will not be charging their cart customers an estimated \$2 per month for the clean-up program. However, the County of Fresno has authorized a new On-Call Bulky Item Pick-up service for the collection of bulky items in the unincorporated areas of the County for residents and businesses.

Residents may contact the ESAP Hauler that serves the address of the pick-up location to arrange for collection. ESAP Hauler will set the cost of the service, based on the type and quantity of materials to be collected and disposed. The County will make available a \$40 value coupon to each resident, each year to help defray the cost. The ESAP Hauler will come to your residence and/or business location to pick up the bulky items and redeem the coupon.

**OR**

Residents may take items to a participating Permitted Facility and redeem the coupon.

The coupon **must be used within 90 days** of the date issued, and **funding for the program is limited**.

To participate in the \$40 Coupon Program, you must reside in the unincorporated area of Fresno County. The following information will be required to issue the coupon:

- Your name
- Your mailing address
- The address of the pick-up location
- Your daytime phone number
